ROTARY

ROTARY was formed in 1905 by a Chicago lawyer, Paul Harris, who began to meet with three friends at lunch time. The name 'Rotary' came from the fact that the members met in rotation at the offices of each of them.

Other clubs were soon established and by 1914 eight clubs had been created in Great Britain and Ireland. The Burntwood Club was founded in 1987. Today there are over 1,500 Clubs in Great Britain and Ireland, approximately 21,000 Clubs worldwide, and it is, in fact, the largest fellowship of men and women in the world, with over one million members.

The motto of 'Rotary' is "Service above self". The objectives of Rotary include the fostering of high ethical standards in business and the professions and the advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace through a world-fellowship of business and professional people united in the ideal of service.
